APPLICATION

An application is appended for a premises licence for the Crown Hotel, Church Street, Barmouth, LL42 1EW by Mr Abdul Jalil, Esha House, Manor Avenue, Pwllheli LL53 5AF.

The applicant is submitting the application in order to have the right to sell alcohol on the premises between 17.00 and 23.00, seven days a week.

CONSULTATION

There has been a consultation on the application and one letter of response has been received from the owner of a nearby business. Allegations are made in the letter of a history of legal breaches relating to other sites owned by Mr Jalil. The allegations made are relevant to the licensing objective of preventing crime and disorder.

Following receipt of the letter, the UK Border Agency was consulted regarding the allegations made by the Objector. An e-mail was received from the Agency that will be distributed during the meeting of this Sub-committee for your attention and to assist you in your decision.
