## Key Question 3: How well do the learning experiences meet the needs and interests of learners and the wider community?

Grade 1: Good with outstanding features

- 104 There is a good programme to promote pupils' spiritual development in personal and social education, English and religious education and through visits to local churches. However, the school does not have an overview of each subject's contribution to the programme. School assemblies offer little opportunity for pupils to reflect on spiritual issues.
- 105 There are outstanding features in the way the school promotes pupils' moral, social and cultural development. Many activities, both in school and in the community, promote pupils' maturity and self-discipline and encourage values such as honesty and respect. Pupils frequently help and show concern for others by raising substantial sums of money for local, national and international charities. Many aspects of the curriculum promote a strong awareness of Welsh culture. Extra-curricular activities, including visits abroad, widen pupils' knowledge and understanding of other cultures.
