Grade 2: Good features and no important shortcomings

91. The school contributes well to community events and to specific charities, including helping the elderly members of the locality. These links enrich pupils' educational experiences and their personal development, and prepare them well for their role as responsible citizens of their community.

92. The school attends well to the development of pupils' moral, social and cultural values through implementing a wide-ranging programme that also incorporates personal and social education (PSE) requirements. Sessions of 'circle-time', religious education and class discussions about social and moral issues are an integral part of school life and contribute well towards the pupils' development.

93. The presentations during sessions of collective worship are relevant and of good quality. Despite this, insufficient attention is given to the element of worship and, as a result, pupils' spiritual development is insufficiently developed.
