Grade 2: Good features and no important shortcomings

- 94. Learning experiences promote pupils' spiritual, moral, social and culturaldevelopment effectively. Through a range of curricular activities and regular periods such as collective worship and circle time, pupils are encouraged to respect each other and adults. These experiences contribute well towards creating a happy, family ethos within the school.
