## Grade 2: Good features and no important shortcomings

- 182. The curriculum is enriched through offering a range of extra-curricular activities. These contribute well to pupils' personal and cultural development. The programme includes:
  - visits locally and abroad that allow pupils and students to expand their horizons and gain an understanding of other people's lives.
- 183. The school promotes pupils' and students' spiritual, moral cultural and social development well. The school's ethos conveys an awareness of common values and the close and welcoming atmosphere motivates pupils to attain their potential. A comprehensive PSE programme is arranged to ensure that pupils and students:
  - show respect towards each other, staff and visitors to the school;
  - can differentiate between right and wrong;
  - · accept responsibility and display self-discipline, and
  - · show care and concern for others.
- 184. The school conforms to the requirements in relation to collective worship. The morning assemblies, in year groups in the hall, the tutorial sessions that include acts of worship and contributions from subjects such as music, art and religious education promote pupils' spiritual development well.
