Background

1. The purpose of this report is to inform members of developments, since my previous report, regarding allegations against councillors.

Decisions

2. Case 200901335 (Gwynedd Council) – A complaint that a councillor should have declared an interest when a matter was discussed at committee because a person involved was a member of the same chapel. The Ombudsman decided not to investigate because in his view the connection was not close enough to be a 'close personal association' under the code. Consequently there had been no need for him to declare an interest.
