Title	Review of the Standards Committee's Procedure for Hearings

Action :	To review and adopt revised procedure

Background

- 1. The Committee drew up a procedure for hearings of complaints against councillors in April 2011. This was based on the arrangements of other authorities, the procedure followed by the Adjudication Panel for Wales and a model presented at the Standards Conference in 2010.
- 2. Since then of course the Committee has held its first hearing. In light of that experience and of the mock hearing held at the 2011 Standards Conference a revised procedure has been prepared.

The New Procedure

- 3. A revised draft procedure is attached as an **Appendix**. The main changes are:
 - A simpler, easier to read document
 - A meeting between the Chair and the officer advising the committee to consider whether any further steps are required before the hearing.
 - Combining the 'findings of fact' stage and the stage of deciding whether there has been a breach of the code.
 - Simplification of the rules dealing with matters such as late evidence, non- attendance etc.
 - The Chair to give an indication of the type of sanction being considered and giving the parties an opportunity to make representations before a decision on sanction is made.

Other documents

4. A 'script' was prepared for the Chair for the hearing, to facilitate the task of running the proceedings. In future, other documents could be prepared:

- Summary of the procedure during the hearing for distribution to all present
- A sheet listing the issues on which the committee should satisfy itself in order to come to a decision. A copy could also be circulated to the parties beforehand.

Recommendation

5. The Committee's is invited to comments on the hearings process and to consider and approve the attached procedure.
