(A) NOTICE OF MOTION BY COUNCILLOR ANNWEN HUGHES

In accordance with the Notice of Motion received under Section 4.20 of the Constitution, Councillor Annwen Hughes will propose as follows:-

“As Councillors, we are fully aware of the suffering forced upon many Gwynedd residents due to Westminster Government's funding cuts.

We believe, however, that there is an alternative to this ideologically driven attack on public services that is having an adverse effect on local people. The alternative is a levy through a financial transaction tax on activities that has accelerated the wealth of recent greedy London bankers to the detriment of the larger population. I would urge Gwynedd Councillors to support my call on Westminster Government to actively utilise the financial transaction tax, Robin Hood Tax and use the funds to reverse ongoing reduction to the central grant supplied to local councils, including Gwynedd.”

(B) NOTICE OF MOTION BY COUNCILLOR MANDY WILLIAMS DAVIES
