Item 6: BUSINESS PLAN TO SUPPORT THE OPTION OF GWYNEDD COUNCIL CONTINUING TO RUN THE LLOYD GEORGE MUSEUM

DECISION

To support the proposal to undertake further work to fine-tune the likely financial deficit and to ask Gwynedd Council to assess the risks involved with the business plan and consequently their ability to commit to further financial contributions in future.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Following the Gwynedd Challenge consultation, the Council decided that it would not be running the Lloyd George Museum from 1 April 2017.

Following the Council's decision, the Chancellor of the British Government announced that the financial deficit would be met by the British Government for three years. The Council agreed to fund the deficit for this year.

In January 2021, the Trustees agreed to commission a Business Plan for the Museum using grant funding from Welsh Government. Following a discussion on the Business Plan, it was agreed to ask the Council to commit to further financial contributions in future.
