1 APPLICATION RECEIVED

- 1.1 An application is appended for a premises licence for Bona Pizza, 23 Holyhead Road, Bangor, Gwynedd LL57 2EU. The applicants Mr Salim Hamdane and Kifl Sohl are seeking a premises licence for a Hot Food takeaway selling Pizza, Kebabs, Burgers and Chips.
- 1.2 The application is made in relation to Provision of Late Night Refreshment Indoors and Outdoors.
- 1.3 The officers of the Licensing Authority are satisfied that there is sufficient evidence that the application has been submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and the relevant regulations, and is therefore valid.

2. Measures recommended by the applicant to promote the licensing objectives

- Private Licensed Security present from midnight until close of business.
- Staff will not allow shouting, abusive, threatening behaviour within or near to the premises.
- Police will be called if any anti social behaviour continues following staff politely asking them to refrain from such actions.
- The applicant states that they will have operational systems and protocols for keeping the Public safe - however no detail is provided beyond this general statement of intent,
- The applicant states that Public safety is paramount and this extends to staff, Security personnel, general public customers and any one that can be affected.
- Signage will be provided to state that CCTV is in operation and that antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated and will be reported.
- Individuals causing a Public nuisance will be banned
- Children will not be allowed in the shop after 9pm unless accompanied by a responsible adult

3.1 North Wales Police

North Wales Police recommend that the conditions below are to be included on the premises licence as follows:

Prevention of Crime and Disorder:

- CCTV will be in operation at the premises.
- CCTV will cover all areas where customers will have access to, with the exception of toilet areas.
- CCTV will be provided to, and made available for viewing when requested by North Wales Police and the Licensing Authority.
- The premises will provide copies of CCTV, this may be downloaded, recorded or sent via an online format when requested by North Wales Police and the Licensing Authority.

3.2 Objections from Members of the Public.

Please see attached the 2 letters from members of the public objecting to the application.

One local individual residing close to Britannia Square , objects on the grounds of Public nuisance , specifically in relation to the increased noise late at night from patrons visiting the premises; as well as the odour nuisance from late night cooking smells

Another letter of objection refers to concerns in respect of the Licensing objectives of the Prevention of Public Nuisance and Public Safety. This letter is presented in the form of a petition.

4 **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that this Committee considers the objections , and approves the application in accordance with the comments of the Police, and requirements of the Licensing Act 2003.
