Re: Lack of Lighting in Llwyngwriol Station Car Park

Llangelynnin Community Council had received a number of complaints, from members of the community, regarding the lack of lighting in the Station Car Park. The complaints being that it is very dark and dangerous for pedestrians to walk from the platform to the road

17.12.14 - Llangelynnin Community Council reported this complaint to Network Rail

05 01.15 – Reply received from Jordan Pepperall, Network Rail [**Incident: 141231-000092**] stating “*although NR is the landowner, the area is under lease to Arriva Trains Wales*” so complaint was forwarded to ATW.

21.01.15 – reply from Arriva Trains Wales [**case ref: ATW-150105-L8W**] confirming that “*there are no lighting columns in this car park and that the only available lighting is on the platform. Network Rail would have to carry out such enhancement to provide lighting. Therefore, we will bring this to their attention at a meeting next week, however at present there are no future plans. Despite the fact that the area is under our lease, it remains their responsibility to carry out this improvement*”.

Llangelynnin Community Council Members are still concerned about the lack of lighting in Llwyngwriol Train Station Car Park and would be grateful if you could bring this matter to the attention of the Cambrian Coast Liaison Committee for discussion at your next meeting and hopefully come to a favorable solution.
