Children and Young People's Consultation Y Berwyn Catchment Area 2017

The Cabinet of Gwynedd Council at its meeting on 24 October 2017 resolved to undertake a statutory consultation process on the future of the Berwyn catchment area schools; in particular the schools of Beuno Sant, Bro Tegid and Y Berwyn.

A statutory consultation period was held in the Berwyn catchment area between 22 November 2017 and 10 January 2018, on the proposal to establish a 3-19 Learning Campus on the current site of Ysgol y Berwyn. This followed the Cabinet's decision in June 2017 to withdraw the proposal consulted on 13 March and 28 April 2015.

Documents were prepared for Key Stage 2 children in the Primary and members of the school Council at the Secondary, and a facilitator was arranged to attend each school to discuss the proposal with the children to ensure that they understood what was being proposed and to provide an opportuity for the Children to voice their opinion on the proposal.

It was explained that the change means that: -

- Ysgol Beuno Sant will close;
- Ysgol Bro Tegid will close;
- Ysgol y Berwyn will close;
- A Learning Campus will be established on the current Ysgol y Berwyn site for 3-19 year olds;
- The current Ysgol y Berwyn site will be adapted to create the new Learning Campus;
- Beuno Sant, Bro Tegid and Berwyn pupils will transfer to the new Learning Campus;
- The Campus will be managed by one Head and one Governing Body;
- OM Edwards, Bro Tryweryn and Ffridd y Llyn schools will remain open and benefit from the Learning Campus.
- A joint committee will be established between the rural schools and the Campus to ensure that the rural schools also benefit from the proposed investment in Bala.

Each session took about half an hour to complete. It included explaining the proposal and completing a questionnaire.


6 schools were involved in the consultation with 76 children and young people involved.

What became clear from the consultation process was that children were willing to adapt to a new situation even though they were worried about bullying, losing friends and teachers, but feedback was generally positive in most schools.
