APPLICATION RECEIVED

An application is attached for a premises licence for 2 Mitre Place, Pwllheli, LL53 5HE by Fatih and Mary Yilmaz of 24 Awel y Môr, Pwllheli. The application is in respect of the provision of hot food as late night refreshments to be consumed on and off the premises.

The owners have held a licence with Gwynedd Council since 2005 with the fast food shop, Pekish, located on 78 High Street, Pwllheli. A licence to sell hot food was previously held on the premises of 2 Mitre Place (namely a fast food shop called Buffalo's), and the hours noted on the application are no different to the hours noted on the licence in the past.

The details of what is requested in terms of licensable activities and hours are included in the table below, as well as in the appendices for the report. Officers from the Licensing Authority are satisfied that there is sufficient evidence that the application has been submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003 and the relevant regulations and is therefore valid.

Measures recommended by the applicant to promote the licensing objectives

- Operate a CCTV system
- Employ door supervisors that are registered with the Security Industry Authority
- Sufficient lighting and fire extinguishers (extinguishers are noted on the floor plan)
- Ensure there is no litter outside the premises
- Dispose of waste at a considerate time

Objections - local businesses

Two letters were received objecting to the application based on the licensing objectives of:

- Public nuisance prevention
- Prevention of crime and disorder

The letters were received from two nearby businesses that express their concerns about the potential anti-social behaviour of customers. They are concerned about public nuisance matters such as litter, sanitary, and noise matters. They are also concerned that the Police do not have sufficient resources to police the area, and that there would be an increase in crime and disorder.
