1. Background

The purpose of this report is to present information to the Committee regarding formal complaints made against members. The report is based on information received from the Ombudsman and the case references are his.

2. Complaints

2.1 Case No. 201503255

Date received: 02/09/15

Complaint

The councillor had terminated a telephone call made to the complainant in relation to an incident where damage was caused to the complainant's property.

Decision

No investigation.

Insufficient information provided to substantiate the complaint and the Ombudsman will not investigate unless there is reasonably strong evidence to suggest a breach of the code.

2.2 Case No. 2665/201504570

Date received: 18/11/15

Complaint

That the councillor's behaviour had been discrimantory and aggressive towards a local group during a meeting of the town council while dicussing an application for funding for that group.

Decision

No investigation.

From the evidence available it did not appear that the matters alleged constituted a breach of the code. The councillor was entitled to ask questions and request verification of details for applicants for funding from the council as part of his duties as an elected member.

2.3 Case No. 7294/201504586

Date received: 18/11/15

Complaint

A complaint, by a fellow town councillor, that the councillor had used his camera to bully and harass him on two seperate occasions and that he had abused him verbally on several occasions.

Decision

No investigation.

At the time of some of the alleged conduct, the individual was not acting as a councillor but as a private individual. The Code of Conduct only applies when a councillor is acting as a private individual in very specific circumtances, which did not appear to apply in this case. The complainant was unable to provide supporting evidence in respect of the other aspects of the complaint.

3. Recommendation
