## Appendix 3: Results of the Consultation on the introduction of a Public Space Protection Order (PSPO) for Caernarfon, Pwllheli and Cricieth

- The consultation opened on the Council's website on 26/2/2024, and a press release was published on 14/03/2024.
- Copies of the draft order, a map of the area of the order, explanatory notes and response envelopes were available in Caernarfon, Pwllheli and Cricieth Libraries, and Siop Gwynedd Caernarfon and Pwllheli.
- Several messages were published on social media during the consultation period.
- Attention and publicity was given to the consultation by a number of publications, including North Wales Live, North Wales Chronicle, and Cambrian News.
- Messages about the consultation were shared on Police and Town Council social media.
