- 1.2 The application is made in relation to Live and Recorded Music Indoors, Late Night Refreshment Indoors and Supply of Alcohol Both on and off the premises.

- New Years eve

- Boxing day

2. Measures recommended by the applicant to promote the licensing objectives

- The applicant aims to join and work with the Caernarfon Pub Watch Scheme
- CCTV we be in place and will keep recordings for 30 days. Two cameras will be on the outside of the building and 6 on the inside.
- Jac y Do will have a Zero tolerance policy on drugs and abusive behaviour towards staff members and members of the public.
- Fire alarms have been placed at the premises and all fire exit routes have been clearly marked.
- An incident/accident report book will also be behind the bar to keep a detailed account of any accidents and will be written on the night of the occurrence.
- Noise pollution will be controlled through a double door entrance
- A Challenge 25 policy will be implemented at the premises and all staff that do not hold a personal licence will receive recognized official training on the prevention of underage sales.

3.1 Objection from Environmental Health

- 3.2 The Department has also been dealing with the planning application for this site. The premises does not presently have planning permission to be used as a pub. Noise control considerations were not adequately addressed in the planning application, and Public protection officers (Environmental Health) have requested that a noise assessment and noise insulation and mitigation measures are undertaken, so as to ensure noise from the property does not cause a

statutory nuisance . There is a building with residential houses located at the back, flats above and residential houses over the road. The officers are concerned that noise that may arise from the site.
