TITLE:	REGIONAL MANAGEMENT OF TRANSPORT WORKSTRAMS AND OUTLINE PROGRAMME
PURPOSE:	For the Sub-Group to approve the recommendation and names suggested to lead on the differing work streams and the outline programme for the next 3 Sub Group meetings.
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1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 In order to manage the specific Transport work streams that need the consideration, input and direction of the Transport Sub Group this paper outlines a practical approach that ensures a balanced contribution from each of the six Authorities within the Region as well as ensuring that the workload is shared equally between the Authorities.

- 1.3 The 6 chief officers with the support of Mr Iwan Prys Jones (Economic Ambition Board) have considered the main work streams which are likely to form part of the Sub Group's discussions during the next 2 years. The chief officers have outlined an option to the Sub Group on whom could lead on each work stream (Table 1). The chief officers undertaking the lead roles on each work stream would be responsible for reporting and updating the Sub- Group as well as ensuring that the direction resolved from any resolution from the Sub-Group are actioned.
