Prior to retirement my occupation would regularly take me to Treborth school were I was a regular visitor.</p> <p>The claimed Footpath is in perfect state, fully tarmaced with very little vehicular traffic. I can say that it is a quiet, safe route. Whilst appreciating that there is a path across the fields, I do not tend to use this route it gets very wet and muddy, it is uneven and not suitable for dogs as there are animals in the fields that I do not like to disturb and it's impossible for my dog to manoeuvre the styles. It is also marshy land and can be dangerous under foot. Having enjoyed the benefits of using this walking route for over 32 years. I really hope that I can continue to use this right of way.</p>
