Follow the road through the woodland, pass the Botanical Gardens and entrance to the Athletics track and continue over the railway bridge before reaching Treborth school. Continue before exiting by the Golf Drive at Treborth Road.”
16	2015 - 2021	When I go for a walk on this footpath, I usually start from my home and head for the brewers' fields and the Antelope Inn. 57	Birth (25/4/88) Now – ongoing.	“Turn off the main Treborth road past the former Treborth leisure (including the driving range) Current map shows right of way, only halfway down towards former Treborth school. This claim is for the right of way to go all the way past the school, down past the athletics track and around until the road/path re-joins main road near Menai Bridge.”
80	1971/80 - 2021	“The footpath starts under the Menai bridge by passing the Antelope Inn. The footpath then goes through the botanical gardens and turns slightly left over the railway bridge. Next to here is the athletics track. After going over the bridge, go straight ahead past the houses on the left and follow the lane round. The lane is between the old school and some grass. Behind the grass are a few trees, here is a track that I have used to walk sometimes too, especially when there are many cars parked in front of the school. At this point, the PROW continues either:- Treborth business park and the A5 at Menai bridge or continue straight along a footpath through the botanical gardens which pins the national coastal path."
130	1990 - 2020	"I use this route as part of a walk that I like to do and I sometimes go with my family. This walk would normally start from Eithiniog, through the Brewer's fields, down towards the Antelope, through the university and past Treborth school. 133	1967 – present (2021)	"From the direction of the Antelope, through the woods and pass the botanic garden over a railway bridge and either onto the track or on the lane passing Treborth school (depending on the weather and the condition of the track) back to the main road passing the mews."
136	2005 - 2019	"My walk would start from my home, and then I would walk over the Menai bridge and turn left into Treborth Nurseries. After walking through the nurseries, the footpath turns left near the athletic track and then over a railway bridge. The footpath continues on the tarmac road past some houses and past the front of Treborth Hall. From here, the footpath continues on the tarmac road, passing the Penrhosgarnedd football club and continuing straight, passing the old campsite before the lane reaches the Treborth Road junction. As I cross the road, I walk into a junction and go down a small lane. As I walk down the lane I pass the golf course on the left. The lane continues for a while before entering the school grounds. This is where the lane continues through, passing Treborth Hall and continuing over the old railway bridge. The footpath passes the running track on the left and turns slightly right to go through the Treborth Botanic Gardens. I walk through the gardens towards the Wales Coast Path heading for the Menai bridge. After arriving at Pont Menai, I will walk on the pavement and back home.”
