#### 1. Recommendation for decision

That the Council notes and supports the revised timetable for holding the consultation on the Single Transfers Vote regime for elections to Gwynedd Council from 2027.

#### 2.Background

- 2.1 At its meeting on the 7th of March the Council adopted a timetable for a statutory consultation process to allow a decision on the adoption of an alternative voting system for Gwynedd Council. However, and subsequently the UK general election was called. In consultation with the political group leaders, it was concluded for several reasons that it would not be appropriate or fair to hold such a consultation during a general election. Therefore, the process was postponed and an alternative timetable for conducting the process established.
- 2.2 This is the proposed timetable for the process with attention to electoral periods to ensure a decision before 15 November 2024, which is the last day on which a decision can be reached if the regime change is to take place before the 2027 election. Members have already been informed of the revised meeting date.
